| 80-86.99 % | 4,5 | dobry plus | better than good | Generally sound work with some errors. Grade given to students who are above average, but not in the highest group. |
| 70-79.99 % | 4 | dobry | good | Generally sound work with some shortcomings. |
| 60-69.99 % | 3,5 | dostateczny plus | better than satisfactory | Fair but with significant shortcomings. |
| 50-59.99 % | 3 | dostateczny | satisfactory | Performance meets the minimum criteria. Poor but passing. |
| <50% | 2 | niedostateczny | failure | Considerable further work required. |
