## **Rules of the International Security Studies Scholarship Program**

- The Master's degree program "International Security Studies" is a specialization designed to train future leaders in the field of security, who will be prepared to effectively face the ever changing security challenges in the interconnected world of today.
- 2. The program is implemented under the auspices of the Terrorism Research Center, Collegium Civitas.
- 3. The program Partner is the Polish-U.S. Fulbright Commission.
- 4. There are 2 places with **covered tuition** for the full study course (4 semesters) available for candidates from **Central Asia (former USSR countries)**: Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan.
- 5. Candidates interested in applying for the scholarship should indicate their intention to apply for such a place in the application form by writing: "ISS Scholarship" in the field PROMO CODE.
- 6. Candidates interested in the scholarship apply no later than by **August 18**, 2019 11:59 PM (GMT+2).
- 7. Candidates are obliged to pay the application fee accordingly to regular application rules.
- 8. The selection of scholarship recipients will be made between August 19 and August 30 based primarily on the candidates' academic track record and English proficiency level. Other factors (such us e.g. former professional experience in the field of security) may also be taken into consideration.
- The successful candidates will have the tuition covered provided they pass the consecutive semesters. If they fail to pass a semester, the scholarship will be withdrawn.
- 10. The Rector has the right to revoke the program at any time, provided that the rights acquired by the applicant are respected until the day the program is cancelled.
