This year, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Republic of Indonesia will hold the 3rd Bali Democracy Students Conference (BDSC III) at Nusa Dua, Bali, 5 - 6 December 2019, themed "Democracy and Inclusivity: Youth and Inclusive Digital Democracy".
